My Aged Care service type search	The workgroup discussed searching for service types on My Aged Care and the results that come up. Often can be difficult to filter appropriate services and know which one is best placed

Measuring Impact on Loneliness	 <u>Campaign to End Loneliness</u> website has a range of resources, such as <u>Measuring Your Impact on Loneliness in Later Life</u>. The workgroup discussed the use of different strategies to identify loneliness living in the community. Some of the tools are quite good, and not so intrusiveness. Measurement could be done at the beginning when a new client comes on board and then again during a review after several months, to address impact on loneliness.
